**SUNDAY 8th MAY 2022. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. All riders understand and agree that they ride at their own risk and have their own adequate public liability insurance. NO claim can be made against Her Majesty the Queen, Sandringham Estate, the organisers, volunteers or the benefiting charity for whatever reason.
2. No liability for any damage to any person, horse/pony, vehicle or property, however caused will be accepted. There will NOT be a paramedic, veterinary surgeon or farrier present on the day. Any farrier/vet fees resulting from the ride will be the responsibility of owner/rider. All riders must have their own adequate public liability insurance.
3. **ALL HORSES ATTENDING THE RIDE HAVE BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST EQUINE FLU WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF THE DATE OF THIS EVENT.**
4. Entry fees are non refundable, unless Dr's note or vet certificate is provided, in which case ONE entry refund will be issued ONLY to the rider who is named on the certificate NOT the whole party.
5. Riding hats which are secured at three points, correct PAS 015 or BSEN1384 standard should be worn at all times whilst mounted, along with suitable clothing and footwear. Back protectors are advisable. All horses tack must be of a safe standard, properly fitting and checked by the rider prior to the start of the ride.
6. Children under the age of 16 MUST be accompanied throughout the ride with a responsible adult of 18 years or over. NO horse or pony under the age of 4 years may be entered.
7. The organisers reserve the right to retire any horse/pony or rider without stating a reason. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason.
8. The ride will take place around Sandringham Estate. The ride is NOT competitive and will not be timed. All riders completing the course will be awarded a rosette.
9. Riders MUST report to the secretary before commencing and on completion of the ride. Riders MUST wear allocated numbers at all times.
10. The route will be clearly marked and should be strictly followed. Stewards will be present during the day. They are there for your safety so please follow their instructions.
11. **Riders MUST ride safely and with consideration to others. Please ASK BEFORE PASSING and pass in walk. Remember there are young horses and riders taking part!**
12. Horses and carriages are permitted, but MUST be considerate to all riders.
13. No dogs or quad bikes allowed.
14. It is advisable to carry at least one lead rope within each group.
15. **ALL HORSES/PONIES ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO WALK IN THE LORRY PARK.**
16. PLEASE DO NOT DROP LITTER.
17. Entry fees should be sent with completed entry form and signed declaration(s) to Mrs A Holt. Cheques/postal orders should be made payable to **WARRIOR EQUINE CIC.** (SORRY I CANNOT ACCEPT BACS PAYMENTS).
18. **NO-ONE MUST ATTEND THE RIDE IF THEY HAVE HAD OR BEEN IN CONTACT WITH ANOTHER PERSON WHO HAS HAD A POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST WITHIN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE RIDE.**
19. Entry implies acceptance of all these conditions.

## COVID - 19 RULES

The ride has to run under current government guidelines due to Covid-19, so please read carefully the changes below. These rules are in place to keep us all safe, so please abide by them at all times.

- 1) Only pre-entries will be accepted - NO entries on the day. **ENTRIES ARE STRICTLY LIMITED.**
- 2) I have to receive entries and FULL payment by Friday 22ND APRIL 2022.
- 3) Time slots will be given for you to ride. I will try my upmost best to give You a start time in your preferred time slot, however, this may not be possible for all riders
- 4) Groups may ride a maximum of 6 riders.
- 5) If riding in a group of 2 to 6 riders, please send all entries in the same envelope, otherwise you may not all get the same time slot.
- 6) **ALL** riders **MUST** sign a declaration and answer the 2 Covid-19 agreements.
- 7) Please only arrive a maximum of 45 minutes before your start time.
- 8) On arrival only 1 rider per group should come and collect their envelope which contains rider number(s), string and tags from the secretary.
- 9) Rosettes will be available, these will be displayed and handed to you. Please do not touch the rosettes before you make your choice.
- 10) Social distancing **MUST** be adhered to at all times.
- 11) A toilet will be available, however, you **MUST** sanitise before and after entering the facility.
- 12) Catering will be available on the day, please social distance whilst waiting in line to be served.

**NO-ONE MUST ATTEND THE RIDE IF THEY HAVE HAD OR BEEN IN CONTACT WITH ANOTHER PERSON WHO HAS HAD A POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST DURING 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE RIDE.**

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

In the face of equine influenza outbreaks the British Equestrian Federation (BEF) have asked all event organisers to ensure that all horses and ponies are vaccinated against equine flu.

Therefore, **ALL** horses and ponies attending the Sandringham Charity Horse Ride on Sunday 8th May 2022 will be required to have received all primary injections against equine flu, these must be given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart and **MUST** have been administered at least 8 days prior to the date of the event.

All horses/ponies booster injection **MUST** have been given on or before the date of their equine flu vaccination the previous year.

If the horse/pony has never received an equine flu vaccination, or their booster injection has exceeded their 12 month renewal date, a new set of equine flu vaccinations will need to be given as described in paragraph 2.

**PLEASE NOTE** ALL horses/ponies passports will need to be shown to the secretary or vet if requested, this is to show that the vaccinations are up to date, failure to produce this will result in not being able to take part in the ride.

**PLEASE BRING ALL HORSES/PONIES PASSPORTS TO THE RIDE!!!**

The above stipulations have been put in place to try and protect your horse/pony contracting equine flu and also to protect the horses at The Royal Sandringham Stud and the horses and ponies who live on the Sandringham Estate.

## DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

### FROM KINGS LYNN – HARDWICK ROUNDABOUT.

Take the **A149** following signs to Hunstanton & Cromer. At Jubilee roundabout (just past Sainsbury's) carry straight on. Carry straight on at the Queen Elizabeths Hospital roundabout. At the next roundabout (Knights Hill Hotel on left hand side), take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit, still staying on **A149** towards Hunstanton. At the village of Babingley, turn right onto **B1439** sign posted to West Newton. Follow road for approx 2 miles. After passing West Newton Village sign, you enter a 30 mile limit zone, the Park Gates are on your left hand side (opposite a row of bungalows), turn left here, through the gates and you are in the lorry/trailer park and the start of the ride.

### FROM HUNSTANTON.

Take the **A149** until you reach the village of Babingley, turn left onto the **B1439** sign posted West Newton, then follow the instructions as above from the point of turning onto the **B1439**.

### FROM FAKENHAM.

At the Fakenham roundabout, take the **A148** towards Kings Lynn. Follow this until you reach the village of Hillington, drive through the village then turn right onto the **B1440** sign posted to Dersingham and Sandringham. After approx 2 miles and at a small crossroads, turn left onto **B1439** (a row of bungalows will now be on your right hand side). Carry on down the hill past the Church, at the bottom of the hill you will come to West Newton Park gates on your right hand side (opposite some more bungalows), turn right here through the gates and you will be in the lorry/trailer park and the start of the ride.
